Commuting to Discover

A great way to save money and have a more productive commute to work is to share your drive with other commuters.

When you are carpooling or vanpooling, it makes sense to share the ride and save on fuel, auto maintenance, tolls and wear-n-tear on your vehicle.

Finding other commuters is simple!

- 1) To start or join a carpool or vanpool: visit PaceRideShare.com, register or log into your existing account and use the FREE matching tool to quickly find other commuters.
- 2) To match to an existing Pace Vanpool, review the following pages, create a commute profile that matches the times and routing of the desired van. From your match list on your profile, select a vanpool image and send an email request to join.
- 3) Test ride on a Pace van free for three days!
- 4) If there isn't an existing vanpool that meets your needs, start your own at PaceRideShare.com. Please note that either the origin or the destination of the trip must be in Northeastern Illinois.



If you have a group of 4 or more carpoolers, consider traveling in a Pace van instead of putting wear-n-tear on your own vehicle.

In the Pace Traditional Vanpool Program, Pace supplies the vehicle and covers all costs including:

- Fuel
- Tolls
- Insurance
- Maintenance
- Roadside assistance
- Van washes

Riders pay a [low monthly fare](#) based on distance and number of participants.

The primary driver rides for FREE and receives 300 personal miles per month.

Back-up drivers receive a discounted rate. Vans can have more than one backup driver.

It's easy to start! Just print and complete the [Pace Vanpool start-up forms](#) and mail them in.
